I respectfully submit my resignation from the Florida Public Service Commission.

I stayed true to setting rates that are fair, just, and reasonable. And I take some pride in having leveled the playing field, consistent with the law, so that the ratepayer, with no protection other than the integrity of five Commissioners, could compete with the monopolies, protected by the 4th Amendment.

Unfortunately, as regards the operations of the Florida Public Service Commission, there is no counterbalance to special interest influence upon the legislature, no citizen/ratepayer group, certainly not elected representatives, and restrictions on the AARP insure that even the inherent decency and fair-mindedness of that group is unavailing. A corruptible legislature is at the heart of the Public Service Commission's dysfunction.
