IG Beasley,

Concerning my investigation into the US Foods case has inextricably led me to the belief that there are other conspirators and other persons of interest that we have yet to investigate or refer to another agency do so. For example, the lobbyist for US Foods for many years was a former General Counsel for the Executive office of the Governor. The lobbyist resigned from US Foods when he was appointed to General Counsel for Governor Scott. I can find no evidence that US Foods retained another lobbyist after that gentleman was appointed General Counsel. This capital connection could come back to cause an embarrassment to Secretary Jones, as well as the entire Department. I would like you to reconsider your position and directive not to investigate or seek a referral to another agency concerning the various corporations who I now believe fronted for US Foods, while reviewing past records concerning the completion of the Whistle Blower report.

I know you have instructed me not to investigate this matter any further and "we" would not indict a corporation. Based on the information while working on the Whistle Blower report that I was directed to complete, I feel it would be in the best interest of the Department to expel this information. Because of the vast amounts of federal money involved, I'm asking you to reconsider your stance and refer this case to the D.C. Justice. As a sworn law enforcement officer, I feel I cannot ignore this evidence, and I leave this issue in your hands. Absent a specific directive from you, I intend to include this information in my Whistle Blower report.
